What Are the Uses of Online Storage Service

Cloud storage simply means a hard drive on the internet, a place to store your files and easily access them from any device, anywhere in the world. Let's take a look at the uses of online storage service.

Personal file storage

Personal file storage services are aimed at private individuals, offering a sort of network storage for personal backup, file access, or file distribution. Users can upload their files and share them publicly. Document-sharing services allow users to share and collaborate on document files. These services originally targeted files such as PDFs, word processor documents, and spreadsheets. However many remote file storage services are now aimed at allowing users to share and synchronize all types of files across all the devices they use.

File sync and sharing services

File syncing and sharing services are file hosting services which allow users to create special folders on each of their computers or mobile devices, which the service then synchronizes so that it appears to be the same folder regardless of which computer is used to view it. Files placed in this folder also are typically accessible through a website and mobile apps, and can be easily shared with other users for viewing or collaboration.

Content caching

Content providers who potentially encounter bandwidth congestion issues may use services specialized in distributing cached. It is the case for companies with a major Internet presence.

Best 5 Free Online File Storage Service

Online storage service has been one of the most popular topic in these years. Therefore, a lot of big companies, like Google, Amazon, Microsoft, start working on their own cloud storage service. Fortunately for you, we've rounded up the best 5 free online file storage to help you pick the one that's right for you.

1. Google Drive

[Google Drive](#) is a file storage and synchronization service developed by Google. It allows users to store files on their servers, synchronize files across devices, and share files. In addition to a website, Google Drive offers apps with offline capabilities for Windows and macOS computers, and Android and iOS smartphones and tablets. Google Drive encompasses a Google Docs, Sheets and Slides, an office suite that permits collaborative editing of documents, spreadsheets, presentations, drawings, forms, and more. Files created and edited through the office suite are saved in Google Drive.

Google Drive offers 15GB of free cloud storage. If you need more than the 15GB of free cloud storage, for \$1.99 per month customers get 100GB of storage, and for \$9.99 per month customers receive 1TB of storage.

2. Box

[Box](#), winner of PC Magazine's Editors' Choice Award, is a cloud content management and file sharing service for personal accounts and businesses.

This service is more of a business-collaboration and work-flow solution than a storage service. In addition, the business versions of Box include access to a variety of work programs, which are integrated with Box's cloud storage and services. Box is fast, secure and simple to use, so you can be productive from anywhere, which is the reason many businesses, including General Electric, P&G and The GAP securely access and manage their critical information with Box. It is available for Windows, macOS, iOS, Android, and Blackberry.

The free package gives you 10GB of free space, but the upgrade is expensive, at \$10/month for only 100GB of storage.

3. Microsoft OneDrive

[OneDrive](#) is a file hosting service operated by Microsoft as part of its suite of Office Online services. It allows users to store files as well as other personal data like Windows settings in the cloud. Files can be synced to a PC and accessed from a web browser or a mobile device, as well as shared publicly or with specific people. It's the obvious cloud storage service for Windows users because it's built into Windows 10. OneDrive's biggest strength is that it works closely with Microsoft Office apps, such as Word or PowerPoint.

OneDrive offers 5 GB of storage space free of charge. There are paid-for plans, of course, and you'll get 50GB of storage for only \$1.99 per month. And if you sign up for Office 365 (as well as all of the other Office 365 features) for \$59.99 per year, you get 1TB of space.

4. Amazon Drive

[Amazon Drive](#) is a cloud storage application managed by Amazon. It offers secure cloud storage, file backup, file sharing, and photo printing. Using an Amazon account, the files and folders can be transferred and managed from multiple devices including web browsers, desktop applications, mobiles, and tablets. Access all of your documents from anywhere, and share them with friends and family, without having to log on to your computer.

All Amazon users receive 5GB of free storage. If you need more than 5GB storage, then for \$59.99 per year you can have unlimited storage.

5. Dropbox

[Dropbox](#) is one of the only cloud storage services to offer clients for Linux and Blackberry, alongside the usual Windows, macOS, Android and iOS

standards. There's an official Windows Phone app too. Dropbox isn't the first cloud-based storage service, but it is the one that popularized it. Dropbox can create a special folder on the user's computer, the contents of which are then synchronized to Dropbox's servers and to other computers and devices that the user has installed Dropbox on, keeping the same files up-to-date on all devices.

Dropbox has received many praise, including the Crunchie Award in 2010 for Best Internet Application, and Macworld's 2009 Editor's Choice Award for Software. The free Basic account comes with a paltry 2GB of storage. You can upgrade to the 1TB plan for \$9.99 per month.

Bonus: how to online backup DRM free eBooks


