
### 1. Text to Speech!


## 2. Speechify


### 3. Voice Dream Reader


## 4. Voice Aloud Reader


## 7. Pocket


## 8. NaturalReader

## 10. Talk For Me



The reason is that all of the text to speech apps don't support DRM-ed books. To make your DRM-ed ebooks read aloud with TTS apps, you need to remove the DRM at first. Here you can have [Epubor Ultimate](#) do the job. Just add your ebooks to the program and start to remove DRM and convert the ebook format. At last just simply upload the DRM-free books to your text to speech apps for listening.
