1. What does Kindle Paperwhite and Kindle Oasis Have in Common?

Although Amazon has not officially released the [all-new Kindle Paperwhite model](#), they have officially started accepting pre-orders for a new 6.8-inch Kindle Paperwhite. There's the standard Kindle Paperwhite starting at \$139.99. What sets the new Kindle Paperwhite 5 apart from earlier paperwhite models is a 6.8" display and thinner borders, adjustable warm light, up to 10 weeks of battery life, and 20% faster page turns.



Both Kindle Paperwhite and [Kindle Oasis](#) share a handful of core features. For example, both have Audible integration for listening to audiobooks on the go, same waterproof rating (IPX8), identical storage options (8GB/32GB), integrated

book store, 300 PPI glare-free e-ink display (purpose-built for reading and easy on the eyes), adjustable warm light, and largely identical software.

2. What Separates Kindle Paperwhite and Kindle Oasis?

The main differences between the Amazon Kindle Paperwhite and Kindle Oasis lie in their price, designs, responsive speed, and displays. The Oasis aims to be easy to hold in your hand with the thin and light ergonomic design and the latest e-ink technology for fast page turns.

First, Kindle Oasis costs much more than the standard Kindle Paperwhite. Second, the Oasis has a slightly bigger 7-inch screen, while the latest Paperwhite 5 has a 6.8 -inch display. Third, both devices use LEDs to light up the screen, but the Oasis (25 LEDs) boasts more LEDs than the Paperwhite (17 LEDs), so the Oasis offers more lighting levels and better uniformity around the screen. Most importantly, only the Oasis allows you to filter out blue light at night, making nighttime reading a more pleasurable experience. In all, Kindle Paperwhite is the best budget Kindle ereader ever, while Kindle Oasis is the high-end product with the most premium ereader experience among Kindle eReaders and the fastest page turns.



Option 2: Kobo Forma and Kobo Libra H2O

There's no arguing that the Amazon Kindles are the most popular eReaders worldwide, but Kobo has some great alternatives, such as [Kobo Forma](#), [Kobo Libra H2O](#), etc. Kobo Forma and Kobo Libra H2O are the two best eReaders on the market. These two products are similar in many aspects, but they also have a few differences.

1. Similarities Between Kobo Forma And Kobo Libra H2O

When it comes to software and user interface, the Kobo Forma and the Libra H2O are absolutely identical. They share many features, including an 8 GB storage capacity, 300 PPI, 512 MB RAM, Kobo's proprietary Comfortight Pro screen technology that includes blue-light filters, water resistance, ergonomic handle with physical page-turn buttons, come with Dropbox support, the option for landscape or portrait mode, and so on.



2. Differences Between Kobo Forma And Kobo Libra H20

The Kobo Libra H20 is the best value eReader you can get right now, while Kobo Forma is the best option for a high-end eReader with a larger screen. The Kobo Libra H20 has 19 LED lights while Kobo Forma has 17 and is way cheaper than the Kobo Forma. Meanwhile, Kobo Libra H20 is a lot lighter than Kobo Forma and has a 7-inch screen while Forma has an 8-inch Full HD screen. Moreover, the smaller Kobo Libra H20 is also the more responsive one. However, the 8-inch Kobo Forma is ideal for reading magazines, manga, and comics.




Option 3: Pocketbook InkPad 3 Pro

Besides big names like Amazon or Kobo, PocketBook is also one of the largest global manufacturers of premium eReaders based on E Ink technology. Additionally, Pocketbook is one of those e-reader brands that do not lock you into a specific ecosystem and allow you to load in your own ebooks or MP3 files. And their Pocketbook InkPad Pro is a new flagship e-reader that has the same size screen as the Kobo Forma and is larger than the Kindle Oasis 3. In all, the Pocketbook InkPad 3 Pro is a great e-reader for the excellent reading experience.

The book-sized PocketBook InkPad 3 Pro is equipped with 16 GB of internal memory and a 7.8-inch E Ink HD screen with 300 PPI. With IPX8 capabilities the device allows you to read in the bath or on the beach without worries. And the adaptive SMARTlight can automatically balance the brightness and color temperature of the screen depending on the lighting and time of day. More importantly, it supports the two most popular audio formats as well – mp3 and m4b.
