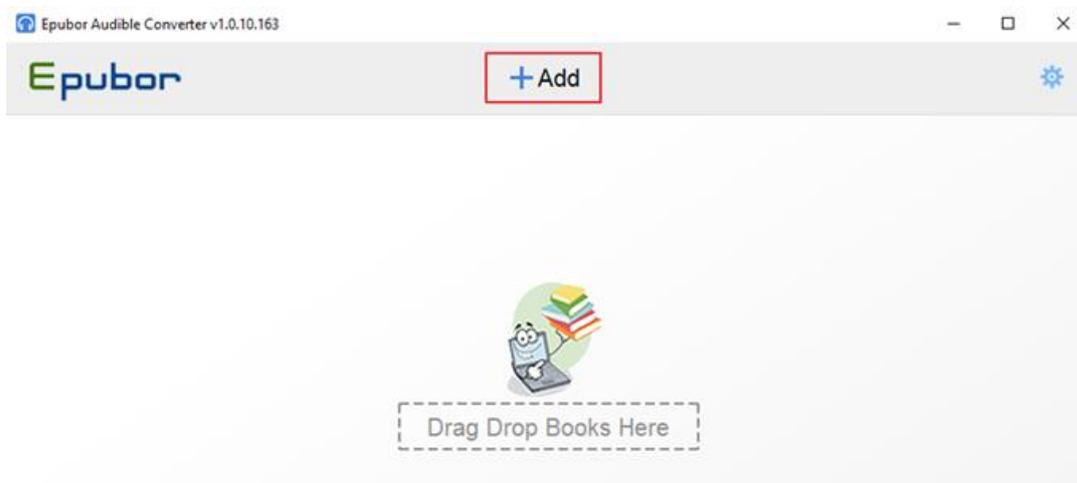
## 2. How to Convert Audible Books to MP3?

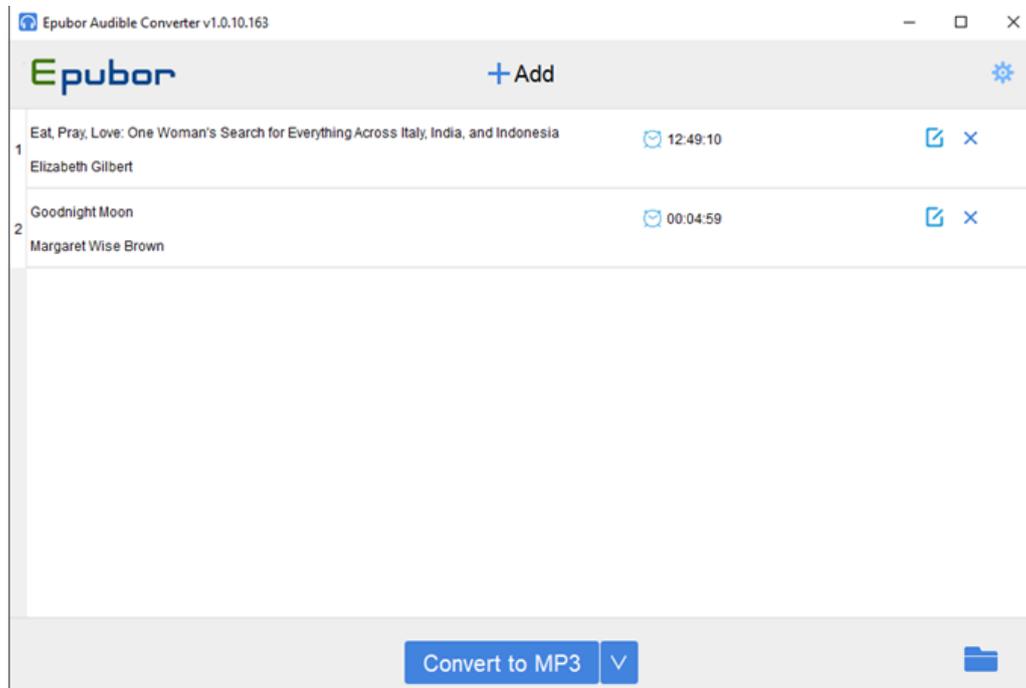


**Tips:** Epubor Audible Converter can detect your downloaded Audible books automatically, all you need to do is click the Add button and select the books.

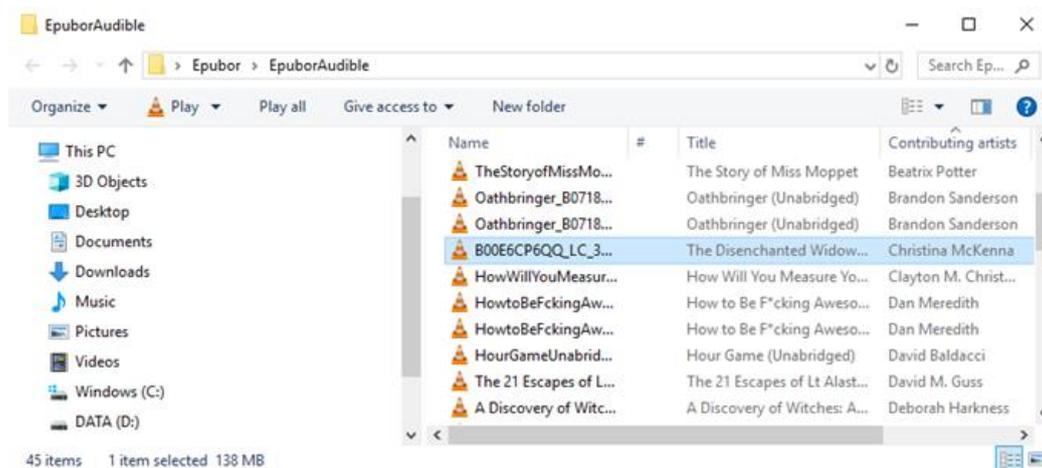
Or you can directly drag and drop AA/AAX files to the main window of Epubor Audible Converter.

Step 3: Convert AA/AAX books to MP3

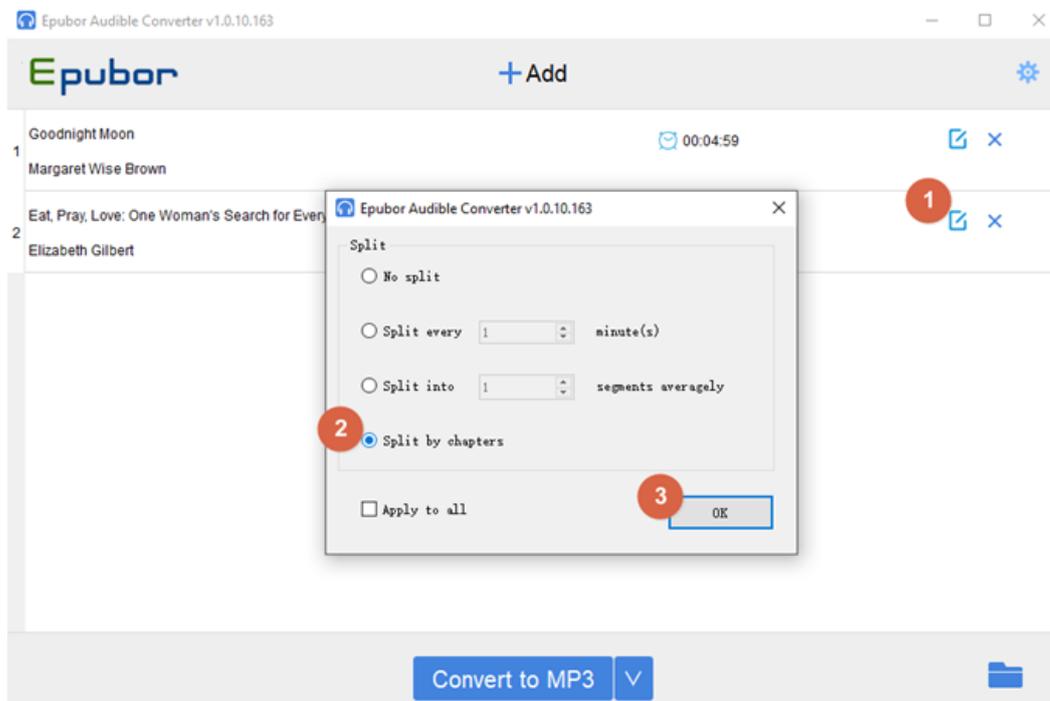
Click **Convert to MP3** button to start the conversion.



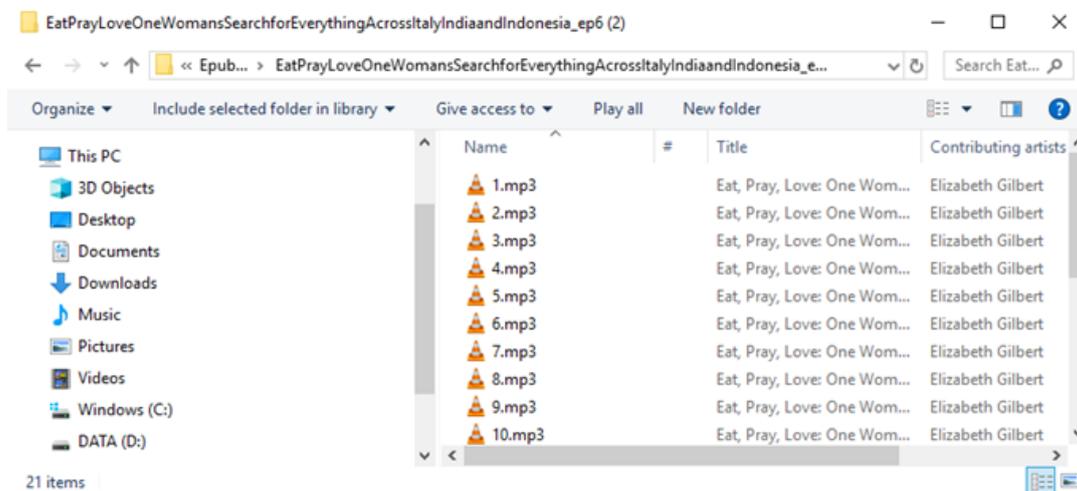
When Epubor Audible Converter successfully convert Audible files to MP3, a pop-up window will contain the MP3 files.



If you want to get the converted MP3 files saved in separated chapters, you need to click the **Edit** button and choose **Split by Chapters** function after adding Audible books to the software. Then click the **Convert** button. Epubor Audible Converter also support split Audible files by average segments and fixed length of time.



Then you will get the converted MP3 files in separated chapters after the successful conversion
